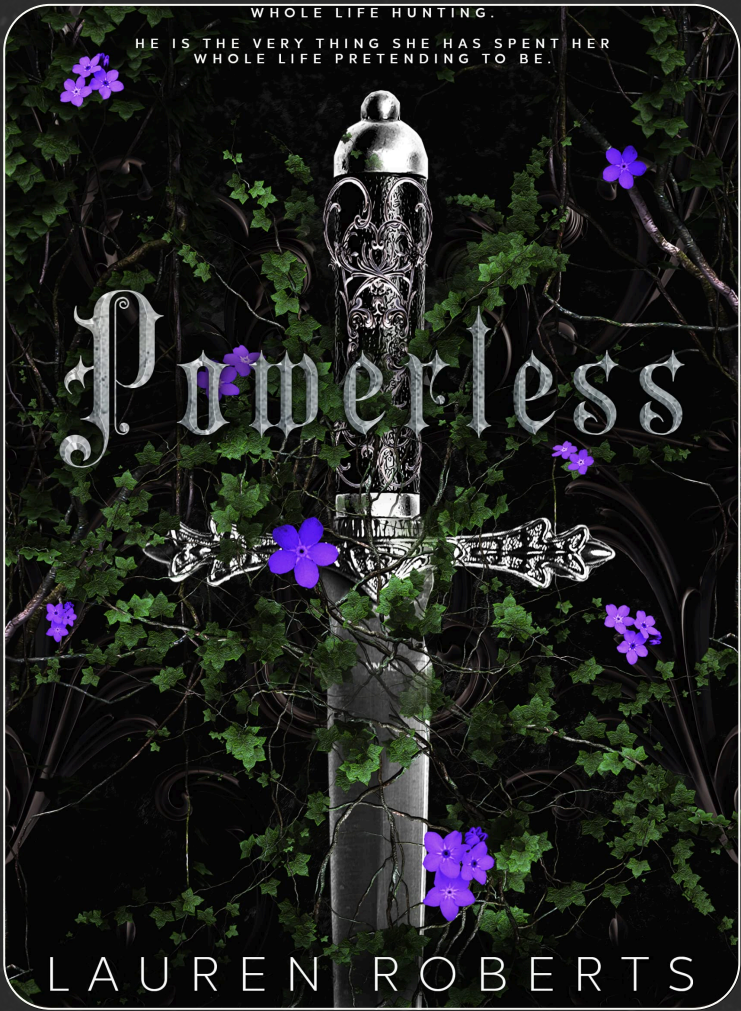


BOOK REVIEW
